ROMANIA

Welcome to ROMANIA!

Romania is situated in the South-Eastern part of Central Europe and shares borders with Hungary to the North-West, Serbia to the South-West, Bulgaria to the South, the Black Sea to the South-East, Ukraine to the North-East and the Republic of Moldova to the East.

Lying at the crossroads of the major routes between the Western and Eastern world, Romania has always played an important geopolitical role for the stability of the whole continent. With a surface area of 238,397 square km, Romania's geographical size ranks 12th in Europe and 79th in the world. Romania is the ninth largest country of the European Union by area, and has the seventh largest population of the European Union, with almost 20 million people living within the country borders.

The capital of Romania is Bucharest, with a population of more than 2 million inhabitants.

Authentic, Natural and Cultural are the three words that best describe the

country, a place rich in history, arts and scenic beauty.

Romania's landscape is almost evenly distributed between mountains (31%), hills (33%), and plains (36%). These varied landforms spread rather symmetrically from the Carpathian Mountains, reaching over 2,400 m altitude (maximum altitude - the Moldoveanu Peak of 2,544 m), to the Danube Delta and the Black Sea coast.

The name "Romania" which was first used when the three regions of the country were united in 1859, reflects the influence of ancient Rome on the nation's language and culture.

The three regions—Walachia, Moldavia, and Transylvania—are relatively culturally uniform. There is a significant Hungarian community in Transylvania (approx. 7% of the Romanian population), which has its own language and traditions. Also, ethnic Roma represent approximately 3.3% of the total population of Romania, according to the 2011 census.

This brochure aims to help both the international students interested in studying in Romania and the higher education professionals who are looking for Romanian higher education institutions to build future partnerships.

We invite you for a journey to discover the many facets of Romania. Whether for a one day trip, a long weekend or a tour across the country, you will have the opportunity to explore and understand the country and its culture.

Besides the main attractions in Bucharest and around the country, such as the Black Sea, with 45 miles of beautiful fine sand beaches, the Danube Delta - the largest and best preserved of Europe's river deltas, the castles (Bran, Peles, Corvinilor), the painted monasteries in Bucovina or Maramures county - extraordinary for traditions and folklore, here are some less well known landmarks definitely worth visiting.

Shall we begin?

Turda Salt Mine "the coolest underground place in the world", according to Business Insider. A unique and real museum of salt mining in Transylvania, Turda salt mine is located 30 km from Cluj-Napoca. It has existed for over 13 million years and it first became available for tourists in 1952.

The salt mine features: health activities, such as medicinal bath salt for rehabilitation therapies in internal diseases and in prevention and sanogenesis; recreation area with swimming pool, spa and wellness centre, playground for kids, mini-golf, bowling, boating on the underground lake, big wheel, sport field, etc.

Cimitirul Vesel (The Merry Cemetery)

The Merry Cemetery is one of the most unusual places to visit in Romania. Located in Sapinta (Maramures County), the place has become famous for its colourful painted tombstones, illustrating in a poetic, sometimes satirical manner, the people buried and scenes from their lives. Ethnologists say Sapinta's merry cemetery is likely a reflection of attitudes that come from the time of the Dacians, early inhabitants of Romania, and have been passed down through folklore ever since. The historian Herodotus noted the Dacians were fearless in battle and went to their graves laughing, since believing they would meet Zalmoxis, their supreme god.

Danube Delta

The Danube Delta is the second largest and best preserved of Europe's deltas, with a total surface of more than 4,000 km². The Danube Delta Biosphere Reserve has the third largest biodiversity in the world (over 5,500 flora and fauna species),

exceeded only by the Great Barrier Reef in Australia and the Galapagos Archipelago in Ecuador. Here, you can see large populations of pygmy cormorants, red-breasted geese and the largest number of white pelicans and Dalmatian pelicans in Europe. You can explore the Delta as part of a Danube River cruise or on day trips and boat excursions. You can watch the Danube merging with the Black Sea and sometimes you can even enjoy beautiful shows by the dolphins.

Vulcanii Noroioși (Mud Volcanoes)

A rare phenomenon can be seen in Romania, in Buzău county. The mud volcanoes are formed due to natural gas coming out of the ground at a depth of 3,000 m. The gases cross a clay soil and push the water out. A cold mud comes to the surface forming cones, thus appearing similar to volcanoes.

Transfăgărășan

"That's the most amazing road I've ever seen! This is the best road in the world" – Jeremy Clarkson said about Transfăgărășan, in a Top Gear episode. Transfăgărășan is approx. 90 km long and reaches an altitude of 2,042 meters, offering amazing views over the Făgăraș Mountains during the entire trip. Beside the breathtaking views, there are some must-see attractions along the Transfăgărășan: the Vidraru Dam or Bâlea Lake, a glacial lake located at the altitude

of 2,034 meters, close to the highest point of the road, where you can also find the Ice Hotel, built from ice blocks taken from the lake. You can also take a short hike from Bâlea Lake to Capra Lake, another beautiful glacial lake.

The Retezat National Park

The largest old-growth forests in Romania are present in the Retezat Mountains. The park contains a sparsely populated area teeming with wildlife such as Carpathian brown bears, wild boars, European wildcats, to name a few. The Park also includes some of the most remarkable glacial lakes in the country and offers numerous opportunities for paragliding, zip lining, hiking and trekking.

Sighișoara

Sighișoara is one of the most beautiful and best-preserved medieval towns in Europe, being also designated as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO.

Bucovina Monasteries

The painted Monasteries of Bucovina are one of the most picturesque treasures of Romania and one-of-a-kind architectural sites in Europe. The eight Romanian Orthodox Churches in Suceava County, which date from the 15th and 16th centuries, are also listed as UNESCO's World Heritage Site.

HIGHER EDUCATION SYSTEM

Since 1999, Romania is part of the Bologna Process, a large-scale inter-governmental cooperation to make higher education systems comparable among the 49 European member states.

There are three types of Higher Education Institutions: public, private and defence / military. The public and private universities are under the responsibility of the Ministry of Education, while the defence / military universities are regulated by the Ministry of Defence, Ministry of Internal Affairs or similar entities.

Higher education study programmes accredited periodically by the Romanian Agency for Quality Assurance in Higher Education (ARACIS).

The structure of Higher Education Institutions, the study programmes, as well as the maximum schooling capacity are set annually by the Ministry of Education, via Government decisions. The Romanian higher education system offers the following types of study programmes:

Undergraduate degree programmes

(first cycle – Bachelor), which can be organised full-time, part-time and distance learning, with 180 – 240 ECTS. For full-time education, Bachelor degree programmes' duration is 3 years (with a minimum of 60 ECTS per year), with 4 years for university education in the fields of Engineering, Law and Theology.

Master degree programmes (second cycle), which can be organised full-time and part-time, with 60 – 120 ECTS, have a duration of 1 – 2 years.

Undergraduate study programmes in the EU regulated fields, which can be organised solely full-time, in a combined university study programme (cycle I and II), have a duration of 5-6 years, the diplomas obtained being equivalent to a Master's degree.

Doctoral degree programmes (third cycle), can be organised full-time and part-time, with 240 ECTS, have a duration of 3 years, with a potential extension of 1 – 2 years in exceptional cases, with prior approval of the University Senate.

For Bachelor and Master programmes, universities issue the Diploma Supplement, describing the level, nature, content, context, and status of the studies completed by each graduate. The Diploma Supplement can be used as a grade transcript for the pursuit of further studies or employment. The bilingual (Romanian and English) Diploma Supplement is automatically issued, free of charge, to all higher education graduates and it is attached to the original diploma in Romanian, together with a description of the national higher education system.

Study programmes in foreign languages

Romanian Higher Education Institutions provide a wide range of Bachelor, Master or PhD programmes in Romanian and foreign languages, such as English, French, German or Hungarian. A number of institutions also offer a Preparatory year in Romanian.

ADMISSION

Calendar

The academic year starts in the first week of October. As Romanian higher education institutions are autonomous, they may decide on the academic schedule. Each year is divided into two semesters. Each semester lasts 14 weeks. Students have a summer holiday (typically from July until late September), a Christmas holiday, an Easter holiday (associated with the Orthodox Easter) and a short holiday (usually one week) at the end of the first semester.

Admission procedure

Access to Bachelor programmes is based on the Baccalaureate diploma (or equivalent), obtained at the end of upper secondary education. Access to Master programmes is based on the Bachelor degree diploma.

Enrolment for doctoral studies requires a Master degree diploma and passing the admission exam organised by the university of choice.

Admission usually starts in March, with the deadline for submitting applications is usually the end July. Depending on the specific study programme or university, candidates may be required to take entrance examinations. For admission to study programmes that require specific aptitudes, the candidates must pass the aptitude test organised by the higher education institution.

The admission procedure main steps:

Step 1: Choose your programme and university

Step 2: Scan your documents

- Passport
- Birth certificate
- High School Diploma / Certificate
- Transcript of records

- Medical certificate
- English certificate - if needed
- Document showing home address

Step 3: Contact the university and apply for your desired programme

- The university will ask for your documents.
- Some universities will provide you with the possibility to register online, but others will ask for the documents in hard copy.
- Send / upload the required documents.
- Pay the application fee - if needed.

Step 4: Wait for feedback

- The university will review your documents and will facilitate the recognition process for your prior degrees.
- Some universities will require a Skype or face-to-face interview or even passing an examination to be admitted (check the details for the specific programme you are interested in).

Step 5: Wait for the Acceptance Letter

Step 6: Pay the tuition fee

Step 7: Apply for a visa online, using the E-VISA portal

Step 8: Arrive in Romania to start your academic journey!

Recognition of diplomas

Romania is a European study destination, which offers the advantage of wide-recognition of its diplomas (according to EU Directives and the Lisbon Recognition Convention), as part of the European Union and the European Higher Education Area. The Diploma Supplement (DS), meant to improve recognition of studies abroad and employability, is issued by all universities automatically and in bilingual format.

SCHOLARSHIPS

International students have multiple options to benefit from scholarships. European students can take advantage of the Erasmus+ programme (for short-term mobilities). Students can apply for different types of scholarships which are awarded by the Romanian Government, inter-governmental or intercultural agreements (bilateral or multilateral agreements) by universities, by different Ministries such as the Ministry of Education, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, or the Ministry of Economy.

According to the national Law of Education, the Government can offer a number of scholarships that cover the international students' tuition fee. These scholarships can be offered to those HEIs (public or private) or study programmes that meet the highest quality standards. The number and amount for state scholarships is determined by Government decision. Higher education institutions can offer scholarships individually or in partnership with other institutions, (such as NGOs), depending on their priorities.

In Romania, scholarships are awarded in the Romanian currency (Romanian lei), are suspended in case of failure to promote a year of study, violation of the Romanian legislation or rules of conduct established by universities. Scholarships are still awarded 30 days after the completion of doctoral or post-university studies. These do not cover the international transport or personal expenses.

Annually, EEA grants offer scholarships to students from Norway, Iceland and Liechtenstein wishing to study in Romania (in an English program) or be part of a research project in Romania.

Scholarships offered by the Romanian state through the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MFA)

Each year, the Romanian Government, through the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, provides a number of scholarships to citizens from non-EU countries. Only candidates having good results in education, respectively an average of the study years, for the last graduated school, of at least 7 (seven) corresponding to the scoring system in Romania or the Good score, as the case, are eligible.

Applicants may select their study program of interest in all fields, with the exception of Medicine, Dental Medicine and Pharmacy. In order to promote the Romanian language and culture, the beneficiaries of the scholarships granted by the Romanian state for undergraduate and Master studies study only in Romanian. The exception is doctoral scholarship holders, who can opt for studies in Romanian or in a foreign language set by the doctoral school. For candidates who do not speak Romanian, a preparatory year is granted for the study of the Romanian language prior to the actual university studies, with the exception of doctoral scholarship holders who have opted for the form of education in a foreign language set by the doctoral school.

The scholarship obtained, including the preparatory year where applicable, consists of:

- financing tuition fees;
- financing the accommodation expenses in the dormitories, through the budget of the Ministry of Education, within the limit of the subsidy allocated for this purpose (accommodation will be provided to the extent of available places);
- granting a monthly financial aid, which varies per level of study.

The scholarships do not cover the costs of international transport and those of domestic transport from the Romanian border crossing point to the university. In this regard, candidates must be prepared for the personal financial support of the additional costs.

The scholarship application process starts in the fall and concludes in March, final evaluation results being available in July, though exact dates may vary from year to year. The required documents include diplomas, transcripts, birth certificate and passport, CV – all described in the application process. Upon selection, additional formalities, such as obtaining a visa, will be required.

Starting with 2021, the application process takes place exclusively online on a dedicated platform, part of the Study in Romania website.

Erasmus+ Scholarships

Erasmus+ offers mobility and cooperation opportunities in the fields of higher education, vocational education and training, school education (including early childhood education and care), adult education, youth, and sport. Higher education students (short cycle/Bachelor/Master/Doctoral) and staff (academic and non-academic) can benefit from an international mobility experience through Erasmus+.

Students registered in a higher education institution and enrolled in studies leading to a recognised degree or another recognised tertiary level qualification are eligible to participate in a study or traineeship mobility. Recent graduates are also eligible to take part in a traineeship mobility within 12 months of graduating. While a study mobility must involve 2 higher education institutions from different countries (one as sending

institution and the second as host institution), for traineeship mobility, the host organisation may be in an enterprise, a research institute, a laboratory, an organisation or any other relevant workplace

An Erasmus+ student mobility may take place, in certain specific conditions, in one of the:

- 27 EU Member States (Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Croatia, Czech Republic, Cyprus, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden);
- third countries associated to the Programme (Iceland, Liechtenstein, North Macedonia, Norway, Serbia, Turkey);
- third countries not associated to the Programme (all other countries).

Tuition fees

Some of Romania's competitive advantages consists in its low tuition fees. Fees can differ depending on the type of student (Romanian/ EU or non-EU), field of study, language of instruction, institution, etc.

In Romania, non-EU students pay higher fees compared to the domestic / EU students. The minimum paying fees for international students differ on level and field of studies.

Institutional autonomy allows universities to set their own fees, starting from the minimum amount established by the law. These can range from 270 to 950 euros per month for Bachelor and Master's degree and up to 970 euros for doctoral studies per month. For medical studies, tuition fees at first cycle level range between 2,000 and 7,000 euro.

LIVING AND WORKING IN ROMANIA

Romania is one of the least-expensive countries in the EU and it has prices for every pocket. Of course, these costs vary based on the city where the university is located, with extra expenses for the larger cities, but still contribute to a competitive advantage compared to other countries.

Cost of living

When it comes to accommodation, various options are available for students.

Most universities in Romania offer on campus dormitories to students, which can be a very good option compared to private accommodation, in terms of costs. These costs vary based on university, city, and type of accommodation, but range between 60 to 100 euros / month. Universities offer comfortable and clean dorms with free internet access, canteen, reading rooms and sport facilities, where rooms have 2 or more beds, private bathrooms and sometimes a kitchenette, while video surveillance is available for most of them.

Properties can also be rented, either through a real estate agent or privately, via public websites or friends / colleagues recommendations. Typically, a security deposit of usually one month's rent is required. Flat-sharing is also an available option, thus lowering the overall costs. While prices differ based on location, for the large(r) cities, they are as follows for 2022:

- studio: 150 to 300 Euro / month.
- one bedroom apartment: 200 to 350 Euro / month.
- two bedroom apartment: 250 to 500 Euro / month.

For the daily life, the most common expenses are listed below (values for 2022):

- Food (canteen / groceries /eating out): 150 Euro to 400 Euro / month
- Gas, Electricity: 50 Euro to 75 Euro / month
- Phone and internet – 20 Euro to 50 Euro / month
- Medical insurance – from 12 Euro / month (either private or at CNAS - The National Health Insurance company, state owned)
- Public transportation – 10 to 30 Euro / month
- National transportation – a train or bus ticket for a 300 Km distance is around 15-20 Euro
- Car maintenance – around 100 Euro / month (but finding parking places may not always be easy or cheap in the big cities)
- Entertainment – 200 Euro / month

The transport network in Romania is fairly developed, albeit not always as fast as in some of its European peers. A large rail and bus network exists, quality roads connect most of the country, and distant cities are connected by domestic flights. Students can benefit from a 50% discount for domestic travel by train, 2nd class, and monthly passes, for which they must present the student card validated for the current academic year, containing specific details. Travel tickets can be purchased only from ticket offices equipped with an electronic system for issuing travel tickets from railway stations and CFR Călători travel agencies.

The biggest cities also have extensive public transport systems, while alternatives such as Uber, Bolt or electric scooters are also available. Urban transportation includes buses, trolleybuses and trams. Students under 26 can benefit from the 50 % discount based on the stamped student identity card, a passport or residence card, marriage certificate (if the case). Each major city has specific costs for public transportation, but they do not vary greatly.

If you decide to apply to and enrol in a Romanian university, there are some benefits you can enjoy as a student here:

- free of charge medical care and psychological assistance, provided in the higher education institution, medical and psychological facilities in public clinics and hospitals;
- at least 50 percent discount domestic public transportation (except for air transport), during the academic year;
- discount entrance fees to museums, concerts, theatres, operas, cinemas, and cultural and sport events, organised by public institutions;
- waiving the tuition fees for almost half of the students enrolled in public universities, based on the candidate's high school performance and/or the results of the admission exams – only for EU/EEA and Swiss students;
- possibility to apply for financial assistance, grants-in-aid, living allowance, social allowances directly to the University, depending on your financial situation – although some are available to EU/EEA/CH students only.

Exact information in terms of which of the above is applicable can be provided by each university.

Healthcare

Students under 26 benefit from free of charge medical care and psychological assistance. These services are provided in the higher education institution and in public hospitals, based on the public medical insurance. Students older than 26 must pay a monthly health insurance fee (approx. 15 Euro / month). All must register with a general physician (family doctor), which provides basic consults and can refer to specialists if needed. Medical care in private clinics is subject to payment.

The emergency number in Romania is 112. This is a free call, also available in English and French. An operator will answer inquiring on the type of emergency services required: police, ambulance, firefighters.

Visa and residence permit

After being accepted in a study programme, the next step is obtaining a visa. Students from EU countries, as well as from certain other countries with which Romania has signed bilateral agreements (e.g. the United Arab Emirates, Japan, South Korea, etc.) are exempted from the Romanian visa requirements. International students can find out detailed information about visa requirements from E-VISA dedicated portal of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

The specific conditions and required documents for obtaining a visa are detailed on the website of the General Inspectorate for Immigration (IGI) – since they may be subjected to periodical changes, it is important to verify before applying for studies.

After arriving in Romania, students must obtain a residence permit, which certifies the right to stay in Romania. The permit can be obtained from the territorial units of the General Inspectorate for Immigration from the county where you live. In order to obtain a residence permit, a number of documents must be submitted at least 30 days before the expiry of the right to stay granted by the visa, and this can also be done online on the dedicated IGI portal.

Working in Romania

International students in Romania do not require a working permit, as long as they hold a residence permit for studying in the country. EU/EEA and Swiss students are not bound by any limits to the number of working hours, though it is not recommended to work full time during your studies. Non-EU students are allowed to work 4 hours/day, without the need to apply for a separate working permit. However, working for more than 4 hours/day requires a work permit – detailed information in this sense is provided and updated by the General Inspectorate for Immigration.

In Romania it is quite common for students to have part time jobs. The most common sources to look for a job are dedicated web portals, career fairs, info desks in universities students associations, or friends / classmates.
